Crystal Quilters Guild began in 1992 with a few women from the Enumclaw area dedicated to the art of quilting, interested in learning, sharing, teaching, and making sure this art form is passed on to future generations. Two of the original members are still active in the Guild today, and everyone has learned so much from them.

Today's membership is made up of 50 or so members from communities surrounding Enumclaw. In addition to making quilts for themselves, the members work together to make "COMFORT" quilts that are donated to a variety of Centers in Enumclaw, and Franciscan Hospice in Tacoma just to name a few. Last year they were able to donate over 300 quilts all made from fabric that Guild members have donated in addition to their time.

A public reception for the artists will be held on Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup> from 3 to 4:00 pm at Enumclaw City Hall, Gallery 2018.
